RULES:

1. Maximum two contestants per boat. You may fish by yourself.
2. Only largemouth, smallmouth and spotted bass can be weighed.
3. All bass must meet the minimum requirements of Tennessee 2010 Reservoir Regulations (measured with mouth closed).
4. A GOLDEN RULE will be the official measuring device.
5. Fish with artificial baits only. No live bait or trolling is allowed.
6. Live wells will be checked prior to start of the tournament.
7. Five (5) fish limit per boat.
8. Two (2) ounce penalty for each dead fish. More than two dead fish will result in disqualification.
9. Late penalty: Eight (8) ounces per minute, 15 minutes late or more your weight will be zero.
10. Cull rule is in effect, live wells are subject to check during tournament hours.
