



Montgomery County Bass Club

Fact Sheet

To become a member of the MCBC you must:

1. Be at least 18 years old or 16-18 years old and a parent also becoming a member.
2. You must be a member or willing to become a member of the Bass Angler Sportsman Society.
3. Willing to participate in MCBC's activities.
4. Fill out a MCBC application and submit it to the membership for approval.
5. Pay annual dues of \$61, at the time of submitting application, which can be prorated depending on your date of entry into the club. Of which \$20 is for club dues, \$30 is for Federation Dues and \$11 is for State Membership Dues.
6. Club members pay half the cost of the shirt and the club pays for the other half. Hats may be purchased upon request through the Tournament Director.

Other facts:

Club Tournament Entry fees \$20 per person with the pay out based on number of entries.

MCBC Members have consistently finished the top of the standings during the State Team Tournaments. With the potential to go all the way to the Bass Master's Classic.

We accept boaters and up to 30% of the membership can be non-boaters. You can either fish as a boater or a non-boater during Club Point Tournaments.
